Seasonal Weight Restrictions will be in effect beginning Thursday, February 17, 2011 at 6 a.m..

There will be no special permits issued while the Seasonal **Weight Restrictions** are in effect.

In accordance with Public Act 300 of 1949, the following are exempt from Weight Restrictions; however speed must be reduced to a 35 mph maximum.

Permits are required for the following exemptions:

- Milk Haulers
- Agricultural Commodities
- Public Utility Vehicles

WHAT ARE SEASONAL WEIGHT RESTRICTIONS?

Seasonal Weight Restrictions help to preserve and protect against wear and tear on Calhoun County Roads that is caused by winter thaw and heavy vehicles.

The Calhoun County Sheriff's Department and the Michigan State Police may enforce seasonal weight restrictions and speed reductions while the Seasonal Load Limits/Frost Laws are in effect.

During this restricted period, State Law requires the following:

- **Reduction in the maximum axle loads by 35% on all types of roads.**
- **Tire loads cannot exceed 450 pounds per inch of tire width.**
- **Reduction in the travel speed limit for trucks to a maximum of 35 miles per hour.**

The following requirements are for CCRC's restricted roadways:

35% REDUCTION

9' or Over between Axles

Normal Load 18,000 lbs/axle

Restricted Loads 11,700 lbs/axle

Over 3 1/2' but under 9' between Axles

Normal Load 13,000 lbs/axle

Restricted Loads 8,450 lbs/axle

Under 3 1/2 Ft. combined weight between Axles

Normal Load 18,000 lbs/axle

Restricted Loads 11,700 lbs/axle

Maximum Load on any Wheel (lbs/inch of tire width)

Normal Load 700 lbs per inch of tire width

Restricted Loads 450 lbs per inch of tire width

THE FOLLOWING ROADS ARE CLASSIFIED AS ALL SEASONAL ROADS (NO RESTRICTIONS APPLY)

- B Drive North from M-66 to 6 1/2 Mile Road
- 6 1/2 Mile Rd from Harper Village Drive to B Dr N
- Raymond Road from Emmett Street to Cliff Street
- H Drive South from West County Line Road to M-66
- Michigan Avenue from Partello Road to 25 1/2 Mile Road
- Morgan Road from M-37 to M-66
- N Drive North from 11 Mile Road to I-69
- Old 27 from Marshall City Limits to Baseline Road
- Old 27 from F Drive South to Tekonsha Village Limits
- T Drive South from 18 Mile Road to 22 Mile Road
- 8 Mile Road from M-60 to South County Line Road
- 22 Mile Road from T Drive South to South County Line Road
- Wheatfield Parkway from 11 Mile Road to Michigan Ave
- 15 Mile Road from Railroad Tracks to Michigan Ave
- Verona Road from Marshall City Limits to Raymond Road
- 11 Mile Road from Verona Road to I-94
- F Drive North from Railroad Tracks to 11 Mile Road
- Homer Road from M-60 to F Drive South
